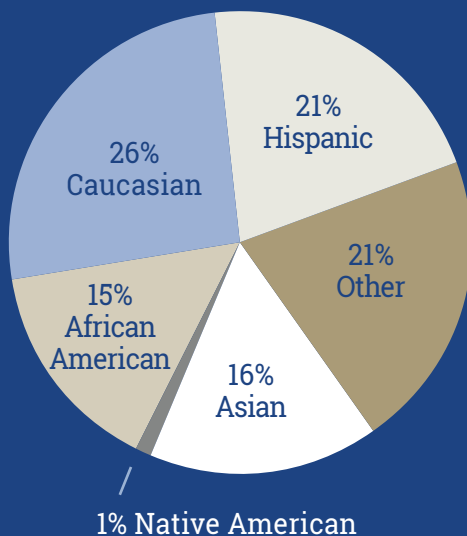
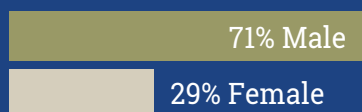

Youth from across New York City (NYC) can enroll in one of three year-round Greater New York Councils (GNYC) Scouting programs (Scoutreach, Volunteer-led Scouting, and Exploring). I. Volunteer-Led Scouting

Traditional Packs and Troops follow the Scouting America advancement curriculum (earning badges and ranks) featuring character education, outdoor adventure, and leadership skills. We do this by partnering with schools, faith-based, and community-based organizations throughout the city who host programs with us in every neighborhood in New York City. Scouting teaches life skills such as teamwork and leadership, as well as a wide variety of other important and valuable subjects that prepare young people for success in life. Career exploration, cyber safety, first aid, swimming, disaster preparedness, cooking, and financial literacy are just some of the life skills that Scouts can learn in volunteer-led scouting.

Cub Scouts: Cub Scouts serves children in kindergarten through fifth grade. The Cub Scouts motto is “do your best.” Children meet weekly for activities with other Cub Scouts and family members. Meetings emphasize learning and being part of a team while having fun.

Scouts BSA: Older youth ages 11-18 engage in weekly meetings and participate in frequent camping trips and other outdoor adventure activities integrated with a comprehensive merit badge advancement program. Scout leaders emphasize developing self-confidence, project management, service, and leadership skills. More than 120 merit badge programs offer unparalleled development opportunities for older youth.

Sea Scouts and Venturing: Older young men and women ages 14-20 can also participate in Sea Scouts and Venturing programs. Sea Scouting teaches boating skills through instruction and practice in water safety, boating skills, outdoor experiences, and knowledge of our maritime heritage. Venturing teaches life skills such as leadership, organization, communication, and responsibility.

The most popular merit badge in 2023 was Citizenship in Society, which explores diversity, equity and inclusion, and the ways in which Scouts can make their Troops, their school and their community, more welcoming to all.

Troops 144B, 1444G, and 4704 from Queens visited the statehouse in Albany to earn this badge while meeting with lawmakers and learning about the budget-making process. Scout Demar Waterman was excited to learn about how young people can make a difference: “I want to be a part of the change in this world and in this country.” Read more in Queens Chronicle here:

II. Scoutreach

We launched four new school-based Cub Scout Packs in our Scoutreach afterschool program, and a new Pack at a migrant family homeless shelter in Manhattan.

III. Exploring

With the goal of helping young people succeed in college and career, Exploring, a co-ed program, serves New York City high school students, by offering a worksite-based career exploration program that provides each student with a professional mentor. There are two types of Exploring programs – Law Enforcement and Career-based.

Law Enforcement Exploring: We offer Law Enforcement Posts at every precinct in the NYPD, and also with the FBI, Diplomatic Security Service, and Customs and Border Protection.

In addition to weekly hands-on sessions, we offer a summer Law Enforcement Exploring Academy, comprised of two weeks in New York City for classroom instruction and drills, and one week of outdoor adventure and training at Camp Keowa in Narrowsburg, NY.

Career-based Exploring: We also offer Career-based Exploring in a variety of other growing employment sectors. GNYC is proud to partner with the following employers who generously donate their time and resources to offer 4-8 weeks of career exploration to the 725 youth served.

Law Enforcement Explorers at Summer Academy, Camp Keowa

Several research studies have demonstrated the positive impact of participating in Law Enforcement Exploring, fostering positive youth outcomes such as higher graduation rates and creating meaningful career opportunities. For example, 64% of Exploring alumni reported having a job in the career sector of their former Post. Other positive outcomes include:

- Explorers' average school attendance was 88.7% vs. 85% for their peers
- Graduation rate was 92% vs. 83.8% for their peers, with the citywide average at 76%
- Regents Diploma rate was 87.1% vs. 76.9% for their peers
- Average GPA of 80.2 among Explorers.

Additionally, Law Enforcement Exploring has been shown to strengthen relationships between youth and law enforcement.

IV. Camping

Children in New York City have few opportunities to stay active and experience nature. At a time when many kids are spending more time on computers and other electronic devices, Scouting encourages youth to get outside and play together. The disruptions and lingering challenges of the pandemic make outdoor adventure and the chance to just be a kid even more meaningful.

The Greater New York Councils owns and operates three nationally recognized camp facilities:

Alpine Scout Camp, located in New Jersey on 400 acres just 10 minutes from the George Washington Bridge, hosts the John E. Reeves Cub World, which offers weeklong camping experiences for 6-10 year old boys and girls. Cub World offers indoor and outdoor climbing facilities, a large swimming pool, a baseball field, a game room, and a technology center.

Ten Mile River Scout Reservation in

Narrowsburg, NY has 15 lakes and ponds for swimming, sailing, canoeing, rowing, an Olympic-size pool, high ropes team-building course, three climbing towers, and terrain that provides hiking, mountain biking, rock climbing, and rappelling opportunities. Throughout the year its winterized facilities play host to weekend trips and it hosts multiple resident summer camps.

William H. Pouch Scout Camp is centrally located in Staten Island on 120 acres and is used for day trips and weekend outings year-round with archery, a fully stocked lake, hiking trails, picnic groves, a playground, and sports fields.

Always striving to serve you better, in the fall of 2023 we surveyed our Scout Leaders to determine the impact of participation in summer camp. Our results consistently demonstrate the extraordinary impact of our programs. A high percentage of leaders see improvement in youngsters' essential life skills. Survey results demonstrate that a high percentage of caregivers found that their Scouts demonstrated improvement in the following areas:

- Leadership94%
- Responsibility.....95%
- Resilience94%
- Teamwork94%
- Communication.....92%
- Caring for Others87%
- Making New Friends88%
- Environmental Stewardship ...82%
- Self-esteem.....92%

An extraordinary 97% of caregivers agreed that summer camp advancement activities helped the Scouts be better prepared academically for the coming school year.

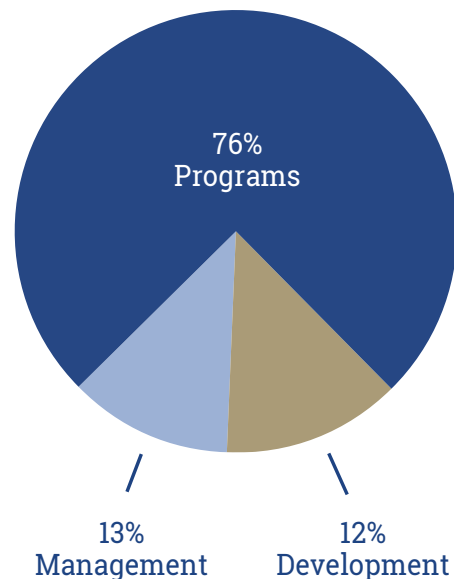
